

My Morrin Program Information

Your ideas brought to life through a program of member-led events

Requirements

1. The proposal is led by a LHSQ member;
2. The event or activity is expected to be of interest to a broad sector of LHSQ members;
3. The event or activity has a cultural theme (arts, heritage or education – the three programming pillars of the Morrin Centre);
4. The event or activity is conducted in English or equally in English and French;
5. The event or activity is free to LHSQ members and any revenue from admission fees charged to non-members is used for future *My Morrin* programming;
6. The budget for events and activities can include honoraria and travel expenses for invited participants, but not for the leading LHSQ member.

Assets

1. The event or activity has local relevance;
2. The event or activity is interactive (e.g., roundtables, workshops);
3. The event or activity is expected to be of interest to potential new members.

Additional information

1. Individual LHSQ members can submit more than one proposal at a time (limit to be determined);
2. Series of events or activities will be considered;
3. Multiple performances are possible if interest warrants.
